Pool Information & Rules Operating Hours

Monday-Friday 10a.m.-9 p.m. Saturday 10a.m.-9 p.m. Sunday 12p.m.-8 p.m.

- ❖ When public schools are in session the pool will have adjusted hours. During the week the times are 12pm-5pm in May and June.
- ❖ Hours will vary during swim & dive season. The pool will close for swim/dive team practice. The hours will be posted at the pool and online.
- ❖ The pool opens full time as of Memorial Day weekend and operates seven days a week through Labor Day.
- The pool is open on weekends only for two weekends prior to Memorial Day weekend and one weekend after Labor Day.

The Windyrush pool is for the use and convenience of the club members. Financial support is provided entirely by the members and as such should be looked upon as personal property.

These rules have been established to:

- Conform to county health department codes.
- Promote a safe and orderly environment.
- Maintain the rights and privileges of members.
- Act as standards to be enforced by the Board of Directors, Club Manager and lifeguards.

Windyrush Swim Club Code of Conduct

The following Code of Conduct reflects expected behavior that supports safe and respectful behavior in and around the pool area. All members and guests are asked to observe and comply with this Code.

SWIMMING POOL: GENERAL:

- All members and guests must register at the front desk. Members must accompany all guests.
- All swimmers must shower before entering pool
- Do not use the pool if you have a communicable disease, open sore or have been ill with diarrhea or vomiting.
- Glass and glass containers and gum are not allowed on the pool deck at any time.
- Food and beverages are not allowed in the pool.
- All food must be eaten away from the poolside.
- Alcoholic beverages must be covered
- Smoking is prohibited on Windyrush property. This
 includes all types of smoking devices and vaping.
- Conventional swimsuits are required, no cut-offs or street clothes allowed. Overly revealing swimsuits (i.e. "thongs" or string bikinis) are prohibited as are Speedos worn outside of competitive swimming. The WRCC board reserves the right to determine if swimwear is inappropriate. Members and guests will be asked to leave or change attire if it is deemed inappropriate.
- During competitive swim and dive events, alcohol is not permitted.

- Pets/Animals are not permitted inside the pool area.
- Swimming is not permitted unless a lifeguard is present.
- There is no lifeguard on duty at the splash pool.
 Parents are responsible for supervision of their children at ALL times in the splash pool area.
 Children age 7 and younger with a parent are permitted in the splash pool. Older children should be in the main pool.

SAFETY

- Lifeguards are an important element of safety at the pool. Members and guests are asked to listen to and abide by instructions of the lifeguards. Lifeguards and all staff are to be treated with respect and dignity at all times. Offenders may be restricted from pool access. Any disagreements with lifeguards should be directed to the Pool Manager or other Manager who may be on duty.
- Swimmers with seizures, heart or circulatory problems are advised to swim with a buddy.
- Rough and excessive horseplay is not allowed. The 3-foot section and areas near the lap swim lane are particularly sensitive in this regard.
- No profanity, abusive language, running, hitting, fighting or shoving is allowed in the pool area or in the pool.
- The swim starting blocks may be used only during swim team practices and meets.
- Hanging on lane dividers is not permitted.
- No back dives/jumps, flips, running dives/jumps from the side of the pool.

 The use of rafts/tubes will be left to the discretion of the lifeguards to insure the safety of all swimmers.

CHILDREN

Parents are directly responsible for looking after their children in and around the pool. Lifeguards are responsible for the safety of all swimmers, and cannot be responsible for supervising unattended, young children.

- If a child cannot competently and independently swim, a parent or supervising adult must be in the pool with the child at all times.
- Children 10 14 must pass a swim test before they
 can swim unaccompanied at the pool. Check
 with the pool office regarding taking the swim
 test, which includes swimming one length of the
 pool. Members of the Dolphin Swim team are
 exempt from the test.
- Any child who has NOT passed the swim test must be accompanied by an adult within reach of the child, AT ALL TIMES, even if the child is using a floatation device.
- Children who are not "potty trained" MUST wear rubber pants over swim diapers when taken into the pool.
- Diapers must be changed in the bathroom area.
 Please do not change diapers on the pool deck.

DIVING BOARD

- Swimmers using the diving board must be able to swim to the wall independently and should swim directly to the side of the pool after diving.
- No flotation devices are allowed on diving boards.
- Divers must jump off the end of the diving board. One bounce only is allowed.
- One person at a time on the board.
- Divers must wait for previous divers to reach the wall before diving.

WATER SLIDE

- Swimmers using the water slide must be able to swim to the wall independently and should swim directly to the side of the pool after sliding.
- Sliders must wait for the previous slider to reach the wall before sliding.
- Swimmers must slide feet first
- One person on the slide at a time.
- No horseplay allowed at any time
- No flotation devices allowed on the slide at any time.

Pool Guest Policy

Members must sign in their guests at the pool desk and pay a guest fee of \$5. A guest may visit the pool only **ONCE IN A SEVEN DAY PERIOD**. There is no charge for out of town guests staying in your home with the exception of the 4th of July holiday. Guest fees on the 4th of July, Labor Day and Memorial Day are \$10.00 per guest. Members must stay for the duration of the guest's visit.

<u>Pool Parties</u>

Pool parties and rentals are permitted and welcomed if appropriately scheduled with the pool manager. Pool party request forms can be downloaded from our website www.windyrush.com. The fee for a party is \$75.00 for a maximum of 15 people (member or non-member) plus lifeguard fee. If you have more than 15, the fee is \$5 per additional person. Two tables will be reserved for your party under the tent. Always confirm with the pool manager for scheduling and pricing details.

Alcohol Consumption

Alcohol will be allowed on club property under the following conditions:

- 1. Adults ages 21+ may consume alcohol on Windyrush property.
- 2. NO GLASS containers in the pool area under any circumstances. This includes coolers and pool bags.
- 3. All alcohol containers must be covered with a Koozie or in a plastic cup.
- 4. The consumption of alcohol will be in moderation. This means that no person shall become intoxicated at the club facilities.
- 5. Consumption of alcohol is a privilege at Windyrush. Please drink responsibly and as a member who represents our club.

Inappropriate Behavior

Behavior should be appropriate to a family club environment and within the norms of accepted community standards. Inappropriate behavior is defined as that which tends to endanger the good order, welfare and character of Windyrush. Any violation is subject to suspension or revocation of club privileges. A copy of the procedures for enforcement is available at the club.

Overflow Parking

Overflow parking in the lower grass area will be opened and monitored by staff and the Board. This area will be used for swim meet parking and holidays as weather permits.
